Subject: Invitation to Enforcement Conference

An Enforcement Conference regarding the findings of the NRC Office of Investigations and the inspection conducted at Creative Biomolecules, Inc., facilities on November 10-11, 1992, will be conducted at the NRC Region I Office, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, on June 7, 1994, at 10:00 a.m. Since our investigation and inspection activities included examination of your involvement relative to the investigation and inspection findings and you may be subject to enforcement action by the NRC, you are invited to attend the Enforcement Conference. (Directions to the Region I office are enclosed.) Your participation in the conference was discussed with you by Dr. Ronald R. Bellamy of this office on May 19, 1994.

The OI investigation concluded that (1) the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) intentionally and deliberately directed an employee to falsify NRC required wipe test records; (2) the RSO made false or misleading statements to an NRC inspector; and (3) the RSO intentionally and deliberately provided false or misleading information to the NRC in a letter, dated September 21, 1992, in response to a Notice of Violation. You were designated as the RSO during the time of these activities.

The purposes of this conference are to: provide you the opportunity to discuss the OI findings, and provide your explanation with any mitigating or extenuating circumstances that will help us determine appropriate enforcement action. In addition, it will provide the licensee an opportunity to discuss the apparent violations, their cause(s) and safety significance; to point out any errors in our inspection report; and to present completed and proposed corrective actions. The proceedings of the meeting will be recorded. A copy of the NRC inspection report and OI synopsis were sent to you as distribution in a May 26, 1994 letter to Charles Cohen, Chairman of Creative Biomolecules, however, we are attaching additional copies to this letter.

Appropriate enforcement action for the apparent violations will be considered by the NRC following the conference and you will be informed of that action by letter. A copy of the NRC Enforcement Policy which is described in Appendix C of 10 CFR Part 2, is enclosed for your information.
