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Gentlemen:

We have completed our review of your revised Emergency Plan dated June 1982. Enclosed is a Safety Evaluation Report (50-346/82-26(DEPOS)) with the NRC staff conclusions. Our review indicated that your plan meets the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50. Please be reminded that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires NRC approval of any changes to your plan which you believe may decrease the effectiveness of the plans. However, if your review indicates no decrease in emergency prepared less, then changes can be made without NRC approval. In all cases, you should furnish copies of each proposed change to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q).

Any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V (Implementing Procedures).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractors) believe to be exempt from disclosure under 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4), it is necessary that you (a) notify this office by telephone within ten (10) days from the date of this letter of your intention to file a request for withholding; and (b) submit within twenty-five (25) days from the date of this letter a written application to this office to withhold such information. If your receipt of this letter has been delayed such that less than seven (7) days are available for your review, please notify this office promptly so that a new due date may be established. Consistent with Section 2.790(b)(1), any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a full statement of the reasons which are the bases for the

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claim that the information should be withheld from public disclosure. This section further requires the statement to address with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR 2.790(b)(4). The information sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a separate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
