During a recent review of the 1982 monthly operating data reports, an error was found in the Unit No. 2 reporting period of April 1982, Item 23 (unit forced outage rate).

The data was reported as:

23. Unit forced outage rate	23.1	17.1	17.1


The data should have been:

	<u>This month</u>	<u>Year to Date</u>	<u>Cumulative</u>
23. Unit forced outage rate	0.0	12.1	16.78

The 23.1 percent was charged to forced outage rate for the month while it should have been 0 percent because this was a planned refueling outage. Consequently, the year-to-date figures through 1982 and the cumulative figures up-to-date for forced outage rate reflected this error.
