SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING RELIEF

REQUEST 940003 - VIRGIL C. SUMMER NUCLEAR STATION, UNIT NO. 1

(TAC NO. M88860)

By letter dated February 17, 1994, you submitted relief request RR-06 in which you asked that the functional and testing requirements prescribed by the Technical Specifications (TS) for snubbers be used as an alternate to the Code requirements of Subarticle IWF-5300. The staff agrees that testing snubbers based on TS requirements alone should be adequate; however, before granting the requested relief the staff requests that you provide clarification of the TS requirements as indicated in the following paragraphs.

- While the sample selection should ensure that the snubbers selected are representative of the various configurations, operating environments, range of size, and capacity of snubbers, such selection should be a <u>random</u> sample of all the applicable snubbers. Is this consistent with Summer Station procedures?
- Snubbers placed in the same location as snubbers which failed the previous functional testing should be retested at the time of the next functional test, but <u>should not be</u> <u>included in the sample plan</u>. Is this consistent with Summer Station procedures?

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 Please provide details of how inspections for snubbers classified as "inaccessible" during normal power operation differ from inspections of snubbers classified as "accessible."

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P. L. 96-511.
