

Request #1:

Please supply a part number for the Ultravue small silicone rubber facepiece.

Response:

The part number for the Ultravue small silicone rubber Chemox facepiece is 805453. In addition, Mine Safety Appliances Company (MSA) now supplies a medium silicone rubber Chemox facepiece (part number 805452) and a large silicone rubber Chemox facepiece (part number 805454) that Beaver Valley also requests authorization to use.

Request #2:

Since these Chemox facepieces are not covered by a NIOSH approval number, please supply documentation that these facepieces have been constructed as other MSA facepieces that are part of NIOSH-approved respirator systems.

Response:

The attached letter from MSA certifies that these Chemox facepieces are of the same construction as other MSA facepieces that are components of NIOSH-approved respirator systems.
