In reviewing your proposal for the approval of Torrey Pines Technology (TPT) to perform the independent management review of the Zimmer construction project the NRC Staff has identified the following additional questions to which we require answers:

- Is there any ownership relationship between the Bechtel Power Corporation (including investments of the Bechtel family) and GA Technologies Inc.? If so, please specify the relationship.
- 2. Please identify all contacts between TPT, or any other division of GA Technologies, and Bechtel on the Zimmer project or any other matter. For each contact, identify the nature of any work performed and the compensation received. Please state what percentage of GA Technologies' (or its predecessor's) earnings for the past three (3) years were generated by work for Bechtel.
- 3. Please identify any contacts between the key TPT personnel identified in your March 7, 1983 submittal and Bechtel on any matter. For each contact, identify the nature of the work performed and the compensation received. As TPT identifies additional profession personnel to be assigned to the review, please provide the same information for these persons.
- 4. Please have each TPT/GA professional who would be assigned to the Zimmer review address in the sworn statements they will file with

the staff the five independence criteria identified on page two of the enclosure to the Chairman's February 1, 1982 letter to Congressmen Ottinger and Dingel as they relate to Bechtel.
