7 Mr. Hoyle, would you proceed, please?

8 MR. HOYLE: The first item for affirmation
9 is SECY-94-112, Licensee Submittal of Data in
10 Computer-Readable Form.

11 The Commission is being asked to approve
12 final amendments to its regulations in 10 CFR to
13 require certain licensees to submit data to the NRC in
14 computer-readable format. These are the licensees who
15 transfer, receive or adjust their inventories of
16 uranium or thorium source material or foreign origin
17 and each specific licensee who transfers or receives
18 one gram or more of contained uranium-235, uranium-
19 233, or plutonium.

20 All Commissioners have approved these
21 amendments and I ask you to affirm your votes.

MR. HOYLE: The second item is SECY-94-131. The title is Advanced Medical Systems.

The Commission is being asked to approve an order in this paper responding to an appeal by Advanced Medical Systems, Incorporated, from an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board decision (LBP-90-17) which sustained the NRC staff's imposition of an immediately effective suspension order on AMS for alleged violations of its license.

All Commissioners have approved an order denying this appeal. May I ask you to affirm your votes?

MR. HOYLE: The third item is SECY-94-144, Intervention Petitions Challenging Proposed Fuel Shipments to Temelin Reactors in the Czech Republic.

The Commission is being asked in this paper to respond to three petitions for leave to intervene and for a hearing on the license application filed by Westinghouse Electric Corporation to export nuclear fuel to the Czech Republic for use in the nuclear facility at Temelin.

1 Commissioners Rogers, Remick, and de
2 Planque have approved an order denying the petition
3 because, as petitioners conceded, the petitions were
4 late filed and the Commission has not found a good
5 cause or other justification to warrant overlooking
6 their lateness. Moreover, the Order concludes that
7 the petitioners lack standing and have not established
8 any right to a hearing, and that a discretionary
9 hearing would not be in the public interest.

10 Chairman Selin recused himself from
11 participating in this matter.

12 I ask Commissioners Rogers, Remick, and de
13 Planque to confirm your votes.

14 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye.

15 COMMISSIONER REMICK: Aye.

16 COMMISSIONER de PLANQUE: Aye.

17 MR. HOYLE: Thank you. That's all I have
18 for today.

19 CHAIRMAN SELIN: In that case, we stand
