Enclosed are three copies of a document containing a description of Weston's Quality Assurance Program, in the form of a Q.A. Matrix and Program Outline demonstrating compliance with ANSI N 45.1, as a means of satisfying the requirements of 10CFR50, Appendix B and 10CFR71, Appendix E. They are submitted for evaluation pursuant to 10CFR71.51 (a). Although the enclosed version of the descriptive document is recent, the program described has been in effect for a number of years with respect to safety related equipment for a 10CFR50 licensed facility.

Weston Controls Division of Fairchild Weston Systems, Inc. is the holder of Byproduct Material Licenses 37-16268-01 and -02G, but has, in the past, shipped only type A quantities of material in DOT 7A packagings. By this submittal, Weston seeks to use the general license of 10CFR71.12 (a), (b) to ship material in packagings manufactured by Weston according to specifications contained in and referenced in Certificates of Compliance, NRC-618. The initial use will involve Certificate No. 9088. Weston has copies of this certificate, the corresponding D.O.T. certificate, and submittals referenced therein dated May 15, 1981 and January 5, 1979.
