
CLOSEOUT OF ALLEGATION FILE RI-92-A-0259  
REGARDING CAMEO DIAGNOSTIC CENTER

The subject allegation file was opened based on a potential staff suspected wrongdoing matter involving the licensee admitting to using NRC licensed material at a location that was not authorized in the license, and the refusal to voluntarily discontinue unauthorized use of materials, ~~until such use was properly discontinued~~. As a result, an allegation panel was conducted on December 16, 1992, with OI in attendance, and the panel decided that OI would evaluate the need to investigate this matter.

In the interim, a Demand for Information was issued to the licensee on December 17, 1992. Further, an inspection was conducted at the licensee's facility on December 29, 1992 during which several violations of NRC requirements were identified. An enforcement conference is scheduled with the licensee for February 18, 1993. These issues are being tracked in the enforcement process under EA 92-246 and EA 93-005.

In memorandum dated January 29, 1993, from B. Letts, Director, OI:RI, to T. Martin, Regional Administrator, RI, OI noted that while its evaluation of the surrounding facts and circumstances indicates that further investigation may be warranted, OI was advised that the priority of the matter is low, higher priority cases take precedence, and OI was closing the investigation.

Based on the above, this allegation file is closed. Tracking of the final disposition of this matter will be done as part of the enforcement process.
