

Dear Ms. Woodhead:

The Board has determined that the information that it has received on the physical description of the Argonaut reactor at UCLA is inadequate for consideration of the inherent safety of the system. The Board therefore requests the Applicant and Staff, to the extent that it has available such material, to submit further material, principally graphics, to aid the Board in understanding the spatial relationship of the various systems which will be under consideration. Of particular importance are graphics of the cooling system, the core structure, the shutdown system and any other graphics which will show their physical relationship. References to available published works encompassing these subjects would also be valuable.

Your prompt attention to this request will be appreciated. We would appreciate receiving this information by June 1, 1983.
