Dear Chairman Wolfe and Drs. Foreman and Jordan:

In accordance with the Licensing Board's October 18, 1982 "Memorandum and Order (Re Applicant's Response (Motion) of September 23, 1982, and Joint Intervenors' Motion (Cross-Motion) of September 29, 1982)," we are enclosing copies of the printer's proof of the public information booklet to be distributed to the general public as part of the off-site emergency preparedness plan. Also enclosed are copies of a color sketch which, when superimposed over the map

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Chairman Wolfe and Drs. Jordan and Foreman
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in the public information booklet, will indicate the color coding for the protective action sections within the plume EPZ. For technical reasons, the color sketch is not a full-size reproduction. In the final booklet, however, the map will be both sized as indicated in the enclosed printer's proof, and colored in accordance with the enclosed color sketch.

In the final booklet, the portion of the "Chart for the 16 Sections around Waterford 3" which deals with sections A1 through A4 will be colored in the same green used for those sections on the color sketch of the map. Similarly, the portion of the chart which deals with sections B1 through B4 will be colored in the same red-violet used for those sections on the map, and the portion of the chart which deals with sections C1 through C4 will be colored in orange, as are those sections on the map. Finally, the portion of the chart which deals with sections D1 through D4 will be colored in the same light blue used for those sections on the map. The panel of text along the right side of the booklet, beside the map and the chart, will be on a light blue background, except that the text in the box at the bottom of the panel will be on a white background.

On the panel to the left of the booklet cover, the text inside the two boxes will be on a light yellow background. The text inside the box on the panel to the immediate right of the booklet cover will also be on a light yellow background. In addition, the text on the panel captioned "What Radiation Is" will be on a light blue background.

As indicated at page 5 of the Board's Memorandum and Order, the enclosed proof takes into consideration the comments of the Staff, FEMA and the Joint Intervenors on Applicant Exhibits 11 and 12^{*}/ (the printer's proof and color sketch submitted on August 19 and 20, respectively). In addition, since the issuance of the

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
