

NOTICE OF DEVIATION

During an NRC inspection conducted on January 27 through February 18, 1994, a deviation from commitments made by the licensee was identified in a letter dated May 18, 1990. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Action," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, the deviation is listed below:

In a letter dated May 18, 1990, the licensee stated, in part, that the "Dresden Station Unit 1 Fuel Pool Noble Gas Monitor (Eberline Model SPING-3A) will be operational by March 1, 1991.

Contrary to the above, as of January 25, 1994, the Dresden Station Unit 1 Fuel Pool Noble Gas Monitor was not operational.

Please provide to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, D.C. 20555, with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region III, 801 Warrenville Road, Lisle, Illinois 60532-4351, and a copy to the NRC Resident Inspector at the Dresden Station in writing within 30 days of the date of this Notice, the reason(s) for the deviation, the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further deviations, and the date when your corrective action will be completed. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
