Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b), et seq., I hereby request that you make available copies of the following documents related to a U.S.N.R.C. meeting held on the dates of January 11-12, 1993 at the Holiday Inn, Bethesda MD; the purpose of which was "Simulation for NRC Workshops for Rulemaking on Radiological Criteria for Decommissioning". The meeting was attended by U.S.N.R.C. representatives of the following divisions: RES, NMSS, NRR, SP, OGC and EDO.

1. Any and all notes, correspondence, reviews, evaluations, action plans and time tables.
2. Any other documents which discuss in any way the "Simulation Workshop".
3. Any and all documents that discuss the policy development of the "Enhanced Participatory Rulemaking for Decommissioning".

Pursuant to NRC regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 9.85, I request that any searching and copying fees incurred as a result of this search be waived.
