SUBJECT:

WORKSHOPS ON ESTABLISHMENT OF RADIOLOGICAL CRITERIA FOR DECOMMISSIONING OF NRC-LICENSED

FACILITIES

The Commission has approved the final plan for conducting an enhanced participatory rulemaking on the radiological criteria for decommissioning NRClicensed facilities. Part of the process contained in that plan is to hold a series of workshops during which invited participants, representing a variety of points of view, will inform the NRC staff of their perspectives on the relevant issues. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), because of its expertise and responsibilities, will not only participate in the workshops--Alan Richardson and Barbara Hostage of EPA's Office of Radiation and Indoor Air will attend all of them--but has been consulted by the NRC staff on the development of the Rulemaking Issues Paper that will form the basis for discussion at the workshops, and will be consulted in the evaluation of the workshop comments.

Detailed arrangements for the workshops are currently being finalized, and packages inviting prospective participants have recently been mailed. Enclosed is a sample package for your information. Besides the letter of invitation, the package includes the Federal Register Notice announcing the workshops. The supplementary information provides an explanation of the purpose of the workshops and how they fit into the enhanced participatory rulemaking, discusses the range of groups sought as participants, covers the workshop locations, schedules, and format, and provides the Rulemaking Issues Paper.
