Please find attached Reportable Occurrence Reports R0-369/83-15 and R0-370/83-03. These reports concern T.S. 3.3.1, "As a minimum, the reactor trip system instrumentation channels and interlocks of Table 3.3-1 shall be operable with response times as shown in Table $3 \cdot 3-2^{\prime \prime}$. This incident was considered to be of no signifinance with respect to the health and safety of the public.

A detailed report on the reactor trip breaker: failures which are the subject of these reportable occurrence reports has been previously submitted to Mr. H. R. Denton (NRC/ONRR) by my letter of April 18, 1983, and should be considered an attachment to these two reports. Note that these or similar reactor trip breaker failures were the subject of NRC/OIE Bulletins $83-01$ and $83-04$, NRC/OIE circular 81-12, and NRC/OIE information notice 83-18. Additional correspondence on this issue includes my letters to Mr. Denton dated February 28, and March 1, 1983; my letters to you dated March 2 and 22, 1983; and Ms. E. G. Adensam's (NRC/ONRR) letter to me dated April 1, 1983. Further, a meeting was held between Duke Power Company and the NRC on April 19, 1983, at which time these incidents were discussed in detail.
