ORDER

The Commission on April 1, 1994 issued an order (CLI-94-4) granting review of LBP-93-25, 38 NRC 304 (1993), and establishing a schedule and instructions for submission of briefs. The Commission's order stated that briefs should not exceed 30 pages, exclusive of the table of contents, table of citations and any addendum. The NRC staff on June 10, 1994 submitted their response to the Native Americans for a Clean Environment (NACE) and the Cherokee Nation's brief. The staff's brief is 39 pages, exclusive of the table of contents or table of authorities.

The staff on June 14, 1994, moved that the Commission accept the brief, or alternatively, that the Commission permit the staff to file a revised brief. The staff indicates that counsel for the Sequoyah Fuels Corporation does not object to this request, and that counsel for the intervenors has no objection to the filing of a revised, shortened brief, but objects to the request for leave to file a brief that exceeds the 30 page limit.

Pursuant to my authority under 10 C.F.R. § 2.772, staff's brief is not accepted for filing. The staff may file a revised brief on or before June 20, 1994. The time for filing of NACE

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and the Cherokee Nation's reply to the responsive briefs filed by Sequoyah Fuels Corporation and by the staff is hereby extended to July 11, 1994.

It is so ORDERED.


