This preliminary notification constitutes EARLY notice of events of POSSIBLE safety or public interest significance. The information presented is as initially received without verification or evaluation and is basically all that is known by IE staff on this date.

Subject: PLANT SHUTDOWN EXTENDED

The plant remains in cold shutdown following the Reactor trip on October 1, 1980. Continuing analysis, initiated by Inspection and Enforcement Bulletin 79-14, identified the need to reinforce a Low Pressure Coolant Injection pipe hanger to insure its operability. The plant is expected to remain shutdown for this modification until October 8, 1980.

Media interest is possible. Neither the licensee or NRC plan to make a press release. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has been informed. 10/3
