SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT COMPONENTS TO JAPAN (XCOM-690)

On October 27, 1982, General Electric Company applied for a license to export two neutron sensors, valued at \$200, to Japan for electronics testing at the Toshiba Laboratory. The applicant has requested expeditious handling of the license application in order for the components to be shipped immediately to meet a critical GE-Toshiba test schedule.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
