SUBJECT: TMI INCIDENT RESPONSE: RETURN TO NORMAL
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

This memorandum cancels my directive of April 30, 1979, authorizing the Controller and the Director, Office of Administration, to waive existing NRC restrictions on travel, overtime and premium pay, within the limits of our statutory authority, in order to provide maximum support to NRC's response to TMI. Effective immediately, any NRC regulations on travel, overtime and premium pay which were waived during the response are fully reinstated.

Also, effective immediately, this memorandum fully reinstates the requirement in NRC Appendix 4136, Part III, B and D, to grant compensatory time in lieu of approved irregular or occasional overtime pay for FLSA-exempt employees whose basic rate of pay exceeds GG-10/10. However, because in some exceptional circumstances there may be a continuing need to pay such employees rather than grant compensatory time, Bulletin NRC 4136-44, "Exception to Permit Payment Instead of Compensatory Time Off for Irregular or Occasional Overtime," has been issued to allow this flexibility.
