PROPOSED EXPORT OF THORIUM TO SCOTLAND-XT08557

By TWX dated November 8, 1982, CERAC Incorporated applied for a license to export 112.98 kilograms of thorium contained in 150.0 kilograms of thorium fluoride in irregular-shaped, broken pieces. This license request covers the same material covered in previously issued Export License XTO8494 which inadverentedly was allowed to expire. The applicant has requested expeditious processing of this license request as the applicant has an order for this material.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the
