Dear Maurice:

As we discussed the other day, my client, Native Americans for a Clean Environment, is interested in attempting to negotiate and resolve, outside of the hearing process, NACE's concerns regarding Sequoyah Fuels Corporation's May 6, 1994, request for a license amendment regarding proposed management changes at the SFC facility. In our telephone conversation, I proposed that NACE would delay requesting a hearing on the proposed license amendment until we had discussed and attempted to resolve our concerns with SFC. You agreed that SFC would not oppose, on grounds of timing, any late-filed hearing request filed by NACE if the negotiations are unsuccessful.

Since speaking with you, I have also contacted the NRC Staff, which has agreed not to oppose as late any late-filed hearing request that NACE files on or before August 15, 1994. When the hearing notice appears in the Federal Register sometime in the next few weeks, I am planning to go ahead and make a hearing request, and ask that it be held in abeyance until further notice or August 15 at the latest, in order to allow time for our settlement discussions.

In the meantime, we are reviewing the license amendment application and preparing a list of the issues that need to be resolved. As part of our review, we are comparing the license amendment application with the existing license and with previous organizational amendments. We have those documents in our files. However, we do not have -- nor does the Public Document Room have -- an up-to-date copy of Part 2 of SFC's license, which also contains relevant information, and which is altered by the proposed amendment. Therefore, I would appreciate receiving a copy of Part 2 as soon as possible.


