This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. T. M. Tongue, M. J. Jordan, and S. Stasek during the period of February 3 through March 15, 1983, of activities at Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 1, 2, and 3, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DFR-02, No. DPR-19 and No. DPR-25 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. R. Ragan and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.
