This transmission confirms the telephone report of November 1, 1982, by F.T. Eisenhuth to E. McCabe of your staff, regarding exceeding the number of allowable cycles the Reactor Recirculation pump discharge valves are permitted, per the SER Supplement 3. A license amendment request will be submitted to change the number of allowable cycles to 25, based on manufacturer's recommendations. Plant operation will continue, based on anticipated receipt of the amendment.

This condition is considered reportable in accordance with Operating License Item 2.G(a).
