

TRAVEL

Your travel plans should be made with these points in mind:

- You should fly into Columbia Metropolitan airport, Columbia, South Carolina.
- You should arrive on Sunday, April 24, 1994.
- Your departure time should be scheduled for Friday, April 29, 1994, after 6:00 pm.
