Florida Power Corporation (FPC) has received your letter dated March 23, 1983, regarding Environmental Qualification of Electrical Equipment. This letter requested a 30 day response to advise of any changes to FPC's February 23, 1983, submittal as a result of our review of your Safety Evaluation (SE) dated January 11, 1983.

FPC's review of this SE is continuing and any changes to the February 11, 1983, submittal, will be included in the May 20, 1983, submittal required by 10CFR50.49. Justification for continued operation is not required at this time since Crystal River 3 is shut down for refueling. Any necessary justification for continued operation will be included in the May 20, 1983, submittal.
