Subject: PROTEST AT TMI NORTH GATE

Four protesters arrived at the TMI North Gate at 10:00 a.m., on April 28, 1983. They are apparently protesting issues related to TMI-1 restart. The licensee has closed the north gate and established access through the south gate.

Media interest may occur because of public sensitivity to TMI related events. Neither the NRC or the licensee plan to issue a press release at this time. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania was informed.

This preliminary notification is issued for information only and the NRC plans to continue monitoring events as they occur.

The NRC TMI Program Office received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the licensee at 10:15 a.m. on April 28, 1983, and this information was current as of 10:45 a.m.
