Dear Mr. Glenn:

The following information is being reported to you in an effort to continue to keep the Commission abreast of the D&D activities at the Revere location.

In our last letter, it was reported that the Site Characterization Report, baring unforeseen difficulties, would be in your possession about May 1. Needless to say, there were some problems with the finalization of that report which had delayed the publication. This report is enclosed for your review.

While this report does a fine job in assessing the ground level contamination, it is notably deficient in addressing the depth of contamination in the soil. This two dimensional approach to the site characterization is insufficient for development of a complete D&D Plan or accurate cost estimates for the implementation of the Plan.

In order to successfully develop the required D&D Plan, Cabot has received a proposal from a consultant for the subsurface study which will determine the depth of the contamination. This task will be accomplished by a excavating a series of trenches and boreholes at the five (5) site location where surface contamination has been characterized. Once this work is complete, the decommissioning cost estimate and the D&D Plan will be developed.
