Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Ronald A. Caldwell of this office on March 1, 1983, of activities authorized by NRC License SNM-799, and to the discussion of our findings with J. T. Prudhomme and other members of his staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection related to your program and activities designed to protect against industrial sabotage and to safeguard special nuclear material. The inspection was based on the applicable provisions of Title 10, Part 70, Code of Federal Regulations entitled "Domestic Licensing of Special Nuclear Material," and the specific requirements of NRC License SNM-799. Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within 10 days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within 30 days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
