SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority/Designation Head of Contracting
Activity (HCA)

TO: Manager, Chicago Operations Office

Department of Energy (DOE) Redelegation Order 0204-90.1 sets forth various authorities delegated to the Director, Office of Procurement, Assistance and Program Management (Director), and provides that these authorities may be further redelegated, in whole or in part, as may be deemed appropriate. This memorandum serves to redelegate to you the specific authority to:

ACQUISITION

Approve, enter into (award/execute), administer, modify, close out, terminate, and take such other actions as may be necessary and appropriate with respect to any contractual arrangement (including interagency and other funds-out agreements), committing the DOE to the obligation and expenditure of public funds; provided, the execution of such actions conforms with applicable laws, regulations, orders, and procedures, including those determinations and decisions as required or described in the Department of Energy Acquisition Regulation; provided further, any such action (other than funding modification) of \$15 million or more, including the value of all priced options or estimates of unpriced options and any contractor cost share or in-kind contributions, shall have the prior approval, or waiver thereof, of the Director or designee, except that, in the case of a subcontract consent/approval action, this amount shall be \$25 million; provided further, that any competitive solicitation intended to result in award of a contract or multiple contracts having a total value of \$10 million or more shall also have the prior approval, or waiver thereof, of the Director or designee. This authority may be redelegated, with the power of further redelegation.

Designate Competition Advocates for each installation that has been delegated contracting authority, and reports to you as HCA, to perform those duties required by the Competition in Contracting Act of 1984, 98 Stat 1175 et. seq. (Public Law 98-369), provided such designation, if below the GM-15 level, shall be approved by me. This authority may not be redelegated. Exercise the determination required by the Federal Acquisition Regulation, in the case of Mistake in Bids alleged after opening bids and before awards, and make

all administrative determinations regarding withdrawal of bids. This authority may not be redelegated.

ASSISTANCE

Approve, enter into (award), administer, modify, close out, terminate, and take such other actions as may be necessary and appropriate regarding financial assistance and financial incentive instruments, including but not limited to grants, cooperative agreements, loan guarantees, price support and guaranteed market agreements, committing the Department to the obligation and expenditure of public funds; provided such actions conform with applicable laws, policies, regulations and procedures; provided further, any grant or cooperative agreement actions of \$15 million or more, including any performer cost share or in-kind contribution and all actions for loans and loan guarantees, price support agreements, and all other such financial incentive actions irrespective of amount, shall have the prior approval, or waiver thereof, of the Director or designee, provided further, any solicitation document which may result in financial assistance or incentive award or multiple awards with a collective value of \$15 million or more shall have the prior approval, or waiver thereof, of the Director or designee. This authority may be redelegated, with the power of further redelegation.

Submit to the Federal Register for publication all notices of financial assistance solicitations. This authority may be redelegated one level below that of the HCA, without the power of further redelegation.

SALES

Approve, enter into, and take such other actions as may be necessary and appropriate, with respect to agreements committing the Department to the sale of products and services, including funds-in interagency agreements and other agreements providing for reimbursable work for others; provided, such agreements are made pursuant to any applicable laws, Executive orders, regulations, and directives governing policies and procedures; provided further, all reimbursable work for others shall have been authorized by the designated official responsible for such work, and statutory, other legal, and regulatory authority to perform the reimbursable work exists. This authorization may be redelegated with power of further redelegation, provided such redelegation to other than contracting officers is no more than two levels below that of the HCA.

PROPERTY

Manage and dispose, consistent with applicable laws, regulations, policies and procedures, all personal property held by DOE for official use by Departmental employees, contractors, and recipients. This authority may be redelegated.

CONTRACTING OFFICERS

Appoint Contracting Officers for acquisition, assistance and sales actions in accordance with DOE Order 4200.4.

Having been delegated the authorities prescribed above for the award of acquisition, assistance, and sales instruments, as well as appointment of contracting officers to help carry out these authorities, you are also designated as an HCA for performance of those functions and duties specifically reserved to an HCA or designee, as may be appropriate. The following DOE organizations are designated Contracting Activities and shall report to you as HCA:



The authorities redelegated by the memorandum are in addition to, and not in limitation of, any other authorities delegated or responsibilities assigned to your office orally or in writing, or by any Departmental directive, regulation, or other issuance.

All actions pursuant to any authority delegated prior to this redelegation or pursuant to any authority redelegated herein taken prior to and in effect on the date of this redelegation are hereby confirmed and ratified, and shall remain in full force and effect as if taken under the redelegation, unless or until rescinded, amended or superseded.

Nothing in this redelegation shall preclude the Director from exercising any of the Director's authority, whenever, in the Director's judgement, the exercise of such authority is necessary or appropriate to administer the functions vested in that position.

This delegation is effective immediately, and supersedes all previous delegation memoranda issued to your office by this office on the above authorities.
