Gentlemen:

This refers to the letter from me to you dated February 8, 1983, which forwarded the results of an emergency preparedness inspection (NRC Inspection Report Nos. 50-10/83-01; 50-237/83-01; and 50-249/83-01) conducted earlier this year. In that letter, I stated that the findings of this inspection were still being reviewed by the NRC staff to determine their proper categorization.

This review has been completed and the NRC staff has determined that there are deficiencies in your emergency preparedness program. These deficiencies are discussed in the enclosed Notice of Deficiencies. Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(s)(2)(ii), if the deficiencies identified in the enclosed Notice are not corrected within four months, appropriate enforcement action will be considered.

You are requested to submit a written statement within thirty days of the date of this letter describing your planned actions for correcting each of the items identified in the Appendix. This description should include: (1) steps which have been taken; (2) steps which will be taken to avoid recurrence; and (3) a schedule for completion of actions for each item.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice" Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your response will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
