As is explained in the complaint and the regulations attached thereto, you may request a hearing by filing an answer with me within 30 days of your receipt of the complaint. Further information regarding the contents of the answer is contained in 10 C.F.R. § 13.9. Failure to file an answer may result in the imposition of the maximum amount of penalties and assessments without right to appeal.
