C.1 BACKGROUND

The US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is scheduling the furnishing and occupancy of the Two White Flint North (TWFN) building to complete the headquarters consolidation in a two-building complex at White Flint.

C.2 CONTRACT OBJECTIVE

The object of this contract is to provide furniture for the TWFN building in sufficient time to meet the spring scheduled occupancy date.

These exclusions presently consist of (i) textiles and apparel articles that are subject to textile agreements; (ii) footwear, handbags, luggage, flat goods, work gloves, and leather wearing apparel not designated as eligible articles for the purpose of the Generalized System of Preferences under Title V of the Trade Act of 1974; (iii) tuna, prepared or preserved in any manner in airtight containers; (iv) petroleum, or any product derived from petroleum; and (v) watches and watch parts (including cases, bracelets and straps), of whatever type including, but not limited to, mechanical, quartz digital or quartz analog, if such watches and watch parts contain any material that is the product of any country to which the Tariff Schedule of the United States (TSUS) column 2 rates of duty apply.

"Components," as used in this clause, means those articles, materials, and supplies incorporated directly into the end products.

"Designated country end product," as used in this clause, means an article that (1) is wholly the growth, product, or manufacture of the designated country (as defined in section 25.401 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)), or (2) in the case of an article which consists in whole or in part of materials from another country or instrumentality, has been

- Description of articles or services, quantity, unit price, and total amount.
- 7. Weight and zone of shipment, if shipped by parcel post.
- Charges for freight or express shipments. Attached prepaid bill if shipped by freight or express.
- Instructions to consignee to notify the Contracting Officer of receipt of shipment.
- 10. For Indefinite Delivery contracts or contracts under which progress payments are authorized, the final voucher/invoice shall be marked "FINAL VOUCHER" or "FINAL INVOICE."

<u>Currency</u>: Billings may be expressed in the currency normally used by the contractor in maintaining his accounting records and payments will be made in that currency. However, the U.S. dollar equivalent for all vouchers/invoices paid under the contractor may not exceed the total US dollars authorized in the contract.

Supersession: These instructions supersede any previous billing instructions.
