

SUBJECT: CABOT CORPORATION REQUEST TO EXPORT COMPONENTS TO
CANADA, XCOM0686

By letter of September 14, Cabot Corporation requested the extension of the expiration date of export license XCOM0436 or, if necessary, the issuance of a new license for the proposed export of 60,500 feet of Zirconium grade II seamless tubing to Japan. This letter also returned the original license which expired on October 1, 1981; it was inadvertently placed in the licenses returned file and, as a result, no action was taken on Cabot's request at that time.

Since export license XCOM0436 has expired, a new license, XCOM0686, is being issued; in light of the above-mentioned oversight, the customary 15-day waiting period is hereby waived.
