APPLICABILITY: MODES 1, 2, 3, and 4.

ACTION:

With the MCC-5 automatic transfer feature inoperable and MCC-5 energized via an onsite electrical distribution system that includes an operable diesel generator, restore the automatic transfer feature to OPERABLE status within 72 hours or be in at least HOT STANDBY within the next 6 hours and in COLD SHUTDOWN within the following 30 hours.

*For Cycle 18 only, the automatic transfer feature will be tested on-line per J. F. Opeka letter to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Haujam Neck Plant, Commitments to Test Motor Control Center - 5, dated July 15, 1993. The MCC-5 automatic transfer feature may be indered inoperable for up to 30 minutes during performance of this test
