Dear Mr. McGorum:

A March 6 letter to you from G. Wayne Kerr of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Office of State Programs has come to my attention. The discontinuance of NRC notifications to you of waste shipments from Three Mile Island would not affect the procedures now followed by this office in relations with the Ohio Turnpike Commission and the Turnpike Police. It seems appropriate to get this on record with you before you respond or react to Mr. Kerr's letter, if indeed you intend to do so.

As you are aware, we coordinate with District 10 of the Ohio State Police when shipments are dispatched, and the Turnpike Police are able to keep tabs on the location of each of our trucks as it moves across Ohio.

I had the pleasure of meeting with the Commission's director, his deputy, and staff, as well as key officers of the Turnpike Police force, a few days ago. I made a brief slide presentation on TMI waste shipment preparation, and we discussed in detail the cask type shipments from TMI which soon will get under way, and also went into emergency response matters.

With regard to notifications by us to your office, we will, of course, be glad to comply with your wishes.
