As you know, we have determined, by talking with a Mrs. Carey, that there is no objection to the use of cameras in the Auxiliary Courtroom on the 27th Floor of the U.S. Court of Appeals in the Everett McKinley Dirksen Building at 219 South Dearborn Street in Chicago. Further, the Commissioners have not objected to the procedure, outlined in the enclosed copy of the Acting General Counsel's March 31 memorandum, proposed for the forthcoming Midland remand proceeding. Therefore, we would propose to use the Commission's "trial" camera policy in connection with this proceeding, and we have arranged for Jan Strasma, Public Affairs Officer in Region-III, to be present for the prehearing conference and at least the first day of the evidentiary hearing.
