Enclosed is a copy of a letter from Jim Hanchett, PAO in Region V, to the Honorable Alfred Goodwin of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit--you may have a copy already. Jim also has sent a copy of his letter to Judge Goodwin to Judge Kilkenny. We are advised by Judge Kilkenny's office (Ms. Kopp) that there will be no objection to the use of cameras during the Trojan proceeding in the Court of Appeals Courtroom (2nd floor)--or Courtroom #2 of the Bankruptcy court--in the Pioneer Courthouse at 555 S.W. Yamhill in Portland beginning on April 17. We will advise you should there be any objection from Judges Goodwin or Kilkenny and ask that you let us know if you have any indication of an objection to the use of cameras during the time the Trojan proceeding is being conducted in these facilities. Jim will be there, at least for the first day, to work with the media.
