The following information contains data that we discussed in our telephone conversation in early August. Please accept my thanks for assisting D. M. Fenwick and J. C. Sabol in my absence due to the illness Joe spoke to you about. Their thanks is also sent to you.

All of the following responses are in reference to amend License No. 37-03572-06 which was dated April 10, 1985.

Item 1 - Radiation Safety Course

Enclosed is a copy of the certificates awarded to J. C. Sabol for his completion of the course entitled "Occupational and Environmental Radiation Protection". Joe is officially our Radiation Protection Officer as mentioned in my memo dated July 11, 1985.

Item 2 - Inventory of Hands and Dials containing Tritium

Attached is an updated inventory list by watch model that have dial and/or hands that are tritium painted. The total in house curies of tritium from this inventory is equal to 87 curies.

Item 3 - Swipe Testing

We have contacted Radiation Physics, Incorporated of College Park, Maryland to handle the analysis end of our swipe testing. Also, please note they will handle our urine bioassays due to economics we discovered following up on the swipe test issue.

Our swipe tests will be done in ten areas of our assembly inspection, and stockroom which are all housed in the third floor of our Wheatland Avenue facility. They will be done on a monthly basis to insure proper levels of radiation containment are met. (See attachment enclosed)

Bioassays will be performed on the operators in each respective area where the hands and dials are handled.

Inspection - 2 operators

Assembly - 4 operators

Stockroom - 1 operator

The bioassays will be forwarded on as monthly basis for analysis to Radiation Physics, Inc.

All operators have been informed of the new procedures by Joe and Dan and will be followed up on by Joe to insure we meet expected levels.


Item 4 - Contingency Plan

In the event we exceed levels that are expected, we will swipe test areas and reclean complete areas until Radiation Physics, Inc. inform us that acceptable levels are now met. Joe will be in charge of the swipe testing and house reports on the results.

Each area will be completely scrubbed with a detergent water solution three times a week to alleviate problems with contamination. In the event of an accident with water, disposal samplings will be sent to Radiation Physics, Inc. for analysis to insure no pollution will be done to the sewer systems of the area.

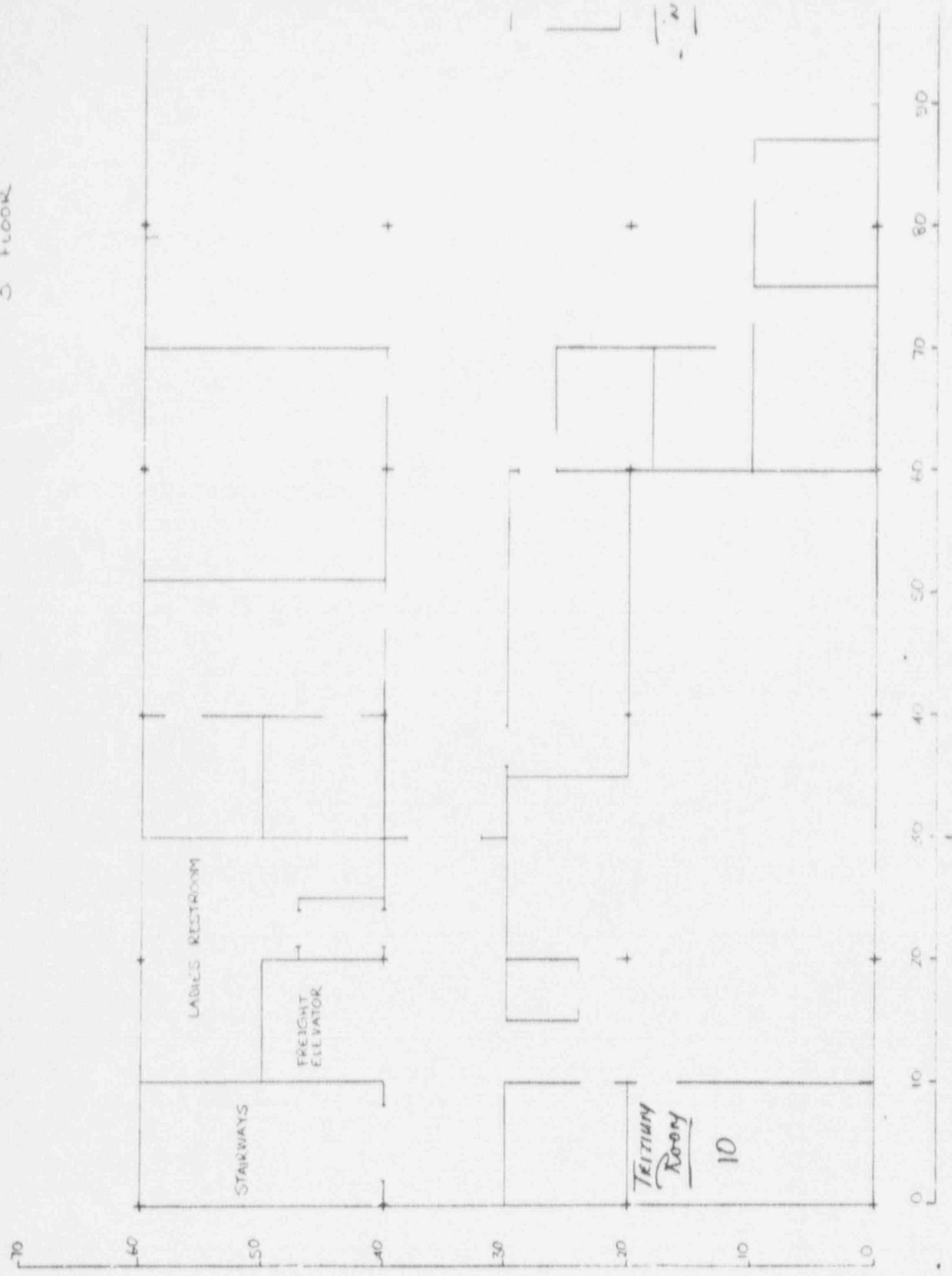
