This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. M. F. Weber of this office on May 10-13, 1994, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License Nos. 21-04109-16 and 21-04109-08, and to the discussion of our findings with Ms. Jan Abelson and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated April 14, 1993, regarding violations found during our March 1 and 2, 1993 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities for License No. 21-04109-16 were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. No violations were identified for License No. 21-04109-08.

Also during this inspection, the inspector reviewed information provided in your letter dated March 16, 1994 in which you described an incident involving an accidental administration of 46 microcuries of I-131 NaI instead of the intended 0.5 microcuries of Co-57 cyanocobalamin for a diagnostic Schilling's test. This incident is still under review and we will communicate to you by separate letter our findings with regard to this matter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
