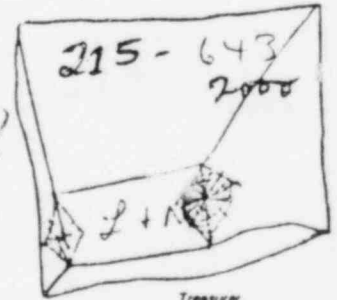
The Pennsylvania Governor's 1979 Occupational Safety & Health Conference will be held at the Penn Harris Motor Inn in Harrisburg on September 5 & 6, 1979. As chairman of the program entitled, "Current Safety Ideas", I would like to invite you to be our main speaker for that session scheduled for 8:30 a.m. on September 6th.

In light of the current energy crisis, the rise in power consumption and the number of nuclear generating facilities and specifically the recent problems with the Three Mile Island plant, many questions for industries located near these facilities have been raised. I also serve on a voluntary basis as the chairman of the Safety & Security Council of the Manufacturers' Association of Delaware Valley which serves over 400 industries located in southeastern Pennsylvania near the Limerick plant under construction by Philadelphia Electric Company.
