Dear Mr. Chilk:

Georgians Against Nuclear Energy is concerned about the safe use of Nuclear Power Plants in the State of Georgia. As you are aware, there are two existing plants in Georgia and two more under construction. GANE is concerned about the new rule regarding offsite emergency planning.

GANE has reviewed the October 14 Petition of the Union of Concerned Scientists for the amendment of the Emergency Planning Rule, 10 C.F.R. 50.47(a)(3). GANE has participated in a variety of governmental proceedings in Georgia. It is particularly interested in emergency planning especially as it relates to the Vogtle Plant under construction at this time.

After reviewing the Petition of the Union of Concerned Scientists, Georgians Against Nuclear Energy respectfully urges the Commission to rule favorably on the proposed amendment sought by the Union of Concerned Scientists. While GANE does not have the resources to participate in this administrative proceeding, it urges you to rule favorably on the UCS Petition.
