
Gentlemen:

I received your Notice of Violation dated March 28, 1989  
concerning License No. 29-21430-01.

First, I want to go on record that I have no position, official  
or otherwise, with Fabco Piping, Inc. That company ceased  
operations and no longer occupies the premises where the  
subject test equipment is located. I have been asked to  
resolve the problem and in that regard I have contacted the  
owner of the premises, gained access to the facility, found and  
identified the test equipment and am currently trying to make  
arrangements with Texas Nuclear Corporation for the proper  
disposal of the test equipment. As we have been advised, the  
equipment must be successfully leak tested prior to shipment to  
the Texas Nuclear Corporation. We are proceeding with this  
step and will keep you advised.
