I thoroughly support the Union of Concerned Scientists petition to the NRC requesting that 10 CFR 50.47 be amended to provide that:

50/47 (a) (3) Throughout any period of low-power operation or fuel loading, the licensing board will retain jurisdiction over the operating license proceeding and maintain an open hearing record. No license for operation at over 5% of rated power will be issued before the completion of adjudicatory hearings on all contested emergency planning issues, including defects in onsite and offsite emergency planning identified as a result of pre-operational emergency preparedness exercises.

I urge adoption of this UCS petition for the following reasons:

1. The proposed amendment is needed to clarify the ambiguous wording in the new rule. The NRC itself does not seem to have a consistent position on the meaning of the rule. For example, NRC staff interpretations of the rule have been inconsistent with those of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in the Zimmer case. A clarifying amendment is needed to establish some consistency in the NRC's treatment of offsite emergency plans.
2. The new rule appears to remove offsite emergency planning from licensing adjudications or at least to weaken the public's right to litigate the issues. This would constitute a violation of law since the evaluation of offsite plans involves material factual issues, which intervenors are entitled to dispute under the Administrative Procedures Act.
3. The new rule suggests that licensing boards may delegate contested matters to the staff for post-hearing resolution. A number of precedents, including the Marble Hill and Three Mile Island cases, have already legally overruled that option.
