Dear Mr. Moore:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Robert G. Gattone, Jr. and Wayne J. Slawinski of this office on April 18, 1994 with continuing NRC review through May 24, 1994 of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 34-08051-01, and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. Although violations 2 and 3 were self-identified and corrective action for these problems were taken or proposed, the violations do not satisfy all the discretionary criteria delineated in Section VII of Appendix C to 10 CFR Part 2, of the NRC's Enforcement Policy. Therefore, these items are included in the Notice of Violation. Specifically, violation 2 is included in the Notice because the adequacy of your proposed corrective action is unknown, since you rarely conduct radiopharmaceutical therapy and hospitalize patients for compliance with 10 CFR 35.75. Violation 3 is included because of its duration and your staff's failure to promptly identify the problem.

A written response is required for violations 1 and 2. No response is required regarding violation number 3 because the inspectors verified that effective corrective actions were implemented to prevent recurrence. These corrective actions included retraining of technologists, posting an instructional worksheet, and notification of the problem to the Radiation Safety Committee Chairman.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
