ORDER

(Granting an Extension of Time)

West Branch Conservation Association (WBCA) has requested permission to file its replies to Licensees' interrogatories on Contention 2.2a late (West Branch Conservation Association's Request for Permission to Reply to Licensees' Interrogatories Late, dated November 24, 1982). WBCA stated it did not receive our November 15, 1982, Memorandum and Order formulating the final contentions until November 19, 1982, the date set forth in the order for filing responses to discovery requests on Commission Questions 1, 2, and 5. WBCA's replies to the interrogatories were filed instantly (West Branch Conservation Association's Replies to Licensees' Interrogatories Dated July 18, 1982, dated November 24, 1982).

WBCA argued that it had to revise its previously prepared responses because it did not know until November 19 that Contention 2.2d had been denied.
