Re: Reply to a Notice of Violation  
License No. 13-24621-01

This letter is in response to the Notice of Violation dated March 19, 1994 regarding an inspection conducted at Flexel Indiana, Inc. in Covington, Indiana on January 20, 1994. There were two violations requiring some action.

1. Two spare krypton-85 gauging devices were located in an electrical workshop, which you feel is not secure against unauthorized removal or access. Even though we feel otherwise, the two spares have been placed in a lead lined crate and are now stored in the electrical supervisor's office, which is kept locked during the off shifts. The box has been labeled as containing radioactive material.
2. We could not provide evidence that the survey meter had been calibrated since 1984. We state in our license application that the meter will be calibrated periodically, which you are interpreting to mean annually. The meter was calibrated on February 14, 1994, and will be calibrated on an annual basis in the future.
