Subject: IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTY - \$2,500

By EN 94-016 dated February 23, 1994, the Commission was notified of the intent of OE to issue a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty (Notice) in the amount of \$2,500. This action was based on the failure of an physician authorized user to wear disposable gloves while administering a therapeutic radiopharmaceutical to a patient at the patient's home. The physician contaminated his finger and received an extremity overexposure.

The licensee responded to the Notice in a letter dated March 28, 1994, and admitted the violation but requested mitigation of the civil penalty. After careful consideration of the licensee's response, the staff has concluded that the violation did occur as stated and that the licensee did not provide any basis for mitigation of the civil penalty amount.

Accordingly, an Order Imposing Civil Penalty in the amount of \$2,500 has been issued today. Under the terms of the Order, the licensee may pay the civil penalty or request a hearing within 30 days of the date of the Order.
