Request for Action Under 10 CFR 2.206

Notice is hereby given that by its Request for Action Re Zion Nuclear Station (Request) dated October 11, 1982, Pollution and Environmental Problems, Inc. (PEP) requested that certain actions be taken by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission with respect to the Zion Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, in regard to usage of high burnup nuclear fuel and the ability of the Zion reactor vessels to withstand embrittlement. The relief requested includes denial of permission for Commonwealth Edison to use high burnup fuel at the Zion facility until a full inquiry into the effect of high burnup nuclear fuel upon embrittlement of nuclear reactor vessels is completed and that NRC provide evidence to the public regarding the Zion facility's capacity to withstand embrittlement. The Request is being treated pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations, and accordingly, action will be taken on the Request within a reasonable time. Copies of the Request are available for inspection in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20555 and in the local public document room for the Zion Nuclear Plant located at the Zion-Benton Public Library District, 2600 Emmaus Avenue, Zion, Illinois 60099.
