Gentlemen/Ladies:

The Washington Management Group is conducting a market research study on facsimile transmission, or "telefax," equipment.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, we request a copy of your agency's inventory of facsimile machines.

Specifically, we would like the following information:

- the equipment manufacturer's name
- the model numbers
- the location of the machinery (address and room number, if possible).
- an indication of whether machinery is owned or leased
- if possible, an indication of the amount of traffic or frequency of transmissions on each machine.

Information of this type is most likely to be found in the Administrative Services Division or in the communications management office of your agency. Paragraph 30 of the Joint Committee on Printing regulations requires that each government agency exercise jurisdiction over and maintain control of printing equipment, which in a broad sense, includes facsimile machines.
