ORDER EXTENDING TIME

I

Sacramento Municipal Utility District, 6201 S. Street, P.O. Box 15830, Sacramento, California 95813 (the "licensee") is the holder of License No. DPR-54 (the "license") issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the "Commission") which authorizes the licensee to operate the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station in Sacramento County, California, in accordance with conditions specified therein. The license was issued on August 16, 1974.

II

On October 20, 1982, the Director of the Office of Inspection and Enforcement issued an Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalties on the licensee. The Order provided that licensee either pay the civil penalties imposed within thirty days of the date of the Order or request a hearing on the Order.

III


On November 23, 1982, the licensee submitted a Request for Reconsideration of the Order Imposing Civil Penalties. The Request submits that the Director did not give sufficient consideration to the licensee's prompt reporting and prompt, comprehensive corrective actions as mitigating factors in assessing the civil penalties, as explicitly provided for in Section IV.B.1 of Appendix C to 10 CFR Part 2, the

"Enforcement Policy." The licensee sets forth a description of the actions taken.

IV

The time within which the licensee must pay the penalty or request a hearing expires shortly. In order for the Director to have sufficient time to evaluate the Request for Reconsideration, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which the licensee must pay the civil penalty or request a hearing on the Order is extended until thirty days following the issuance of a decision on the Request for Reconsideration.
